2 Release Notes

There is a release of the ISWC database software planned for Thu, 4th Jan @ 10:30AM CET. The expected service interruption for the production release is less than thirty minutes.

This release does contain a REST API change so if you integrate directly with the REST API you should consider a quick smoke test in UAT.
