Release Notes

There is a release of the ISWC database software planned for Tue, 9th December @ 10AM CET. The expected service interruption for the production release is three hours.

The purpose of this release is to introduce some new features. It also contains miscellaneous minor bug fixes. This release does contain a REST API change so if you integrate directly with the REST API you should consider a quick smoke test in UAT.
